Our Vision: Recycling offers people and businesses the opportunity to move from an irresponsible waste society into one that takes proper care of their waste streams. By deviating recyclable materials from landfills into re-usable waste streams we can save planetary resources and contribute to the conservation of our mother Earth.

The guiding principles of our operations and our company in general are defined as follow:

- Every aluminum can that we can capture and recycle, is a piece of the Amazons that we are saving.
- Every plastic bottle that we can capture and recycle, is one less that will be entering the environment for 450 years.
- Recycling materials reduces the depletion of the same on planetary level, ensuring continuity of its usage even after its end of useful consumer life.
- Recycling materials contributes to a reduction of energy usage as compared to the conversion of raw materials into new ones, therefore contributing to a reduction of global warming.
- Our approach to sustainability is our commitment to the environment.
- Animals and plants do not have a voice, therefore we hope to be a contribution to their wellbeing and are committed to ensure that we can find an adequate balance in which all species survive in proper conditions and with sustainable biodiversity levels.

The commitment of Green Force is towards providing the means to reduce a series of common threats to life on this planet. The overpopulation of the planet, loss of biodiversity, global warming, destruction of the Amazons and depletion of planetary resources are some of the many dangers all species are facing. - Our attention to environmental, social and economic responsibility includes working within the law and voluntarily exceeding legal requirements in order to be innovative and demonstrate leadership on sustainability issues that are important to us and our stakeholders.

As part of Green Force's sustainability policy we commit to:

1. Minimize environmental impacts of waste for our clients by having their recyclable waste streams be processed and exported for recycling and re-use.

o Currently we offer recycling of the following waste streams: batteries, cardboards, plastic bottles, plastic shrink wrap, aluminum cans and plastic caps.

2. Reduction of emissions are one of the goals for the reduction of Global warming.

o Emissions are reduced through on call pick up system and when travelling, airlines that compensate their carbon footprint and have lesser emissions are being first choice.

o Clients that need service are being grouped into routes in order to maximize transport and reduce unnecessary emissions.

o Machinery is being selected, if possible, taking notice of their electricity consumption, their longevity and their emissions if any.

o As funds come available, a move towards supplying renewable electricity for our machinery will be made. The current energy mix on the island is already 30% renewable.

2. Give back to communities by volunteering and donating resources.

o Green Force gives free recycling education to schools and companies in order to increase awareness and improve recycling rates.

o The owner of the company volunteers in several different groups and actions helping the island towards sustainability. Some of the actions and groups are: The Curaçao Business Council for Sustainable Development. The Chata Sustainability Task Force and the Curaçao Clean Up.

o Funds are being located into tree planting programs, clean ups and animal welfare.

o Green Force is committed to make the general public aware on environmental issues and therefore publicizes many press releases with many different environmental themes.

3. Ensure our supply chain has responsible social and environmental practices.

o We ask our buyers to send us an e-mail in which they guarantee that there is no modern slavery and child labor into their processes. Extra care is being taken for those buyers that handle our hazardous

waste, such as batteries, in such way that we currently work with only ISO 9001 and 14001 certified companies.

4. Create innovative approaches to minimize negative environmental impacts.

o Currently the company works with Limpi, a research and development company who uses our recycled plastics in innovative ways by selling new products.

o We offer our clients a tree planting program participation. This way we can help them create a reduction in emissions and contribute to the enhancement of the environment.

5. Reporting towards the public.

o The commitment is to make public all export numbers based on quantities. The company keeps a close track of exported waste streams for recycling and publicizes this on the website, social media and through press releases.
